Who has believed what we have heard? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed? <sup>2</sup> For he grew up before him like a young plant, and like a root out of dry ground; he had no form or majesty that we should look at him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him. <sup>3</sup> He was despised and rejected by others; a man of suffering and acquainted with infirmity; and as one from whom others hide their faces, he was despised, and we held him of no account. <sup>4</sup> Surely he has borne our infirmities and carried our diseases; yet we accounted him stricken, struck down by God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But he was wounded for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the punishment that made us whole, and by his bruises we are healed. <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray; we have all turned to our own way, and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

GOSPEL LESSON John 19:1-16 Molly Abbott
Then Pilate took Jesus and had him flogged. <sup>2</sup> And the soldiers wove a crown of thorns and put
it on his head, and they dressed him in a purple robe. <sup>3</sup> They kept coming up to him, saying,
"Hail, King of the Jews!" and striking him on the face. <sup>4</sup> Pilate went out again and said to
them, "Look, I am bringing him out to you to let you know that I find no case against
him." <sup>5</sup> So Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. Pilate said to
them, "Here is the man!" <sup>6</sup> When the chief priests and the police saw him, they shouted,
"Crucify him! Crucify him!" Pilate said to them, "Take him yourselves and crucify him; I find
no case against him." <sup>7</sup> The Jews answered him, "We have a law, and according to that law he
ought to die because he has claimed to be the Son of God." <sup>8</sup> Now when Pilate heard this, he
was more afraid than ever. <sup>9</sup> He entered his headquarters again and asked Jesus, "Where are
you from?" But Jesus gave him no answer. <sup>10</sup> Pilate therefore said to him, "Do you refuse to
speak to me? Do you not know that I have power to release you, and power to crucify
you?" <sup>11</sup> Jesus answered him, "You would have no power over me unless it had been given you
from above; therefore the one who handed me over to you is guilty of a greater sin." <sup>12</sup> From then on Pilate tried to release him, but the Jews cried out, "If you release this man, you are no
friend of the emperor. Everyone who claims to be a king sets himself against the emperor."
<sup>13</sup> When Pilate heard these words, he brought Jesus outside and sat on the judge's bench at a
place called The Stone Pavement, or in Hebrew Gabbatha. <sup>14</sup> Now it was the day of
Preparation for the Passover; and it was about noon. He said to the Jews, "Here is your
King!" <sup>15</sup> They cried out, "Away with him! Away with him! Crucify him!" Pilate asked them,
"Shall I crucify your King?" The chief priests answered, "We have no king but the
emperor." <sup>16</sup> Then he handed him over to them to be crucified.
