Come out to meet him. ${ }^{9}{ }^{7}$ Then all those bridesmaids got up and trimmed their lamps. ${ }^{8}$ The foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' ${ }^{9}$ But the wise replied, 'No! there will not be enough for you and for us; you had better go to the dealers and buy some for yourselves., ${ }^{10}$ And while they went to buy it, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went with him into the wedding banquet; and the door was shut. ${ }^{11}$ Later the other bridesmaids came also, saying, 'Lord, lord, open to us., ${ }^{12}$ But he replied, 'Truly I tell you, I do not know you., ${ }^{13}$ Keep awake therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour.
